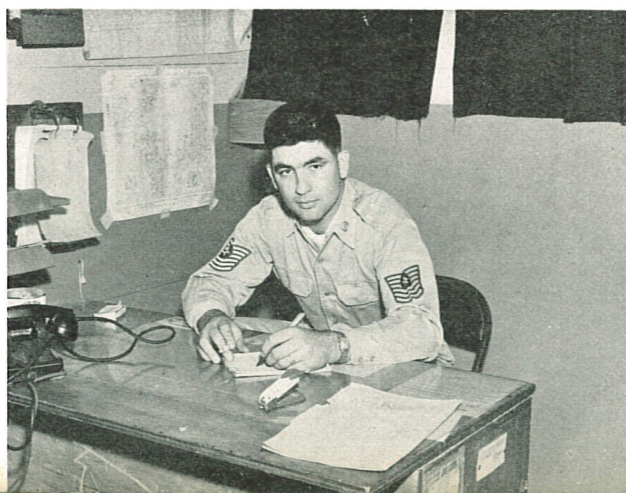

When the 335th Fighter Interceptor Squadron moved to Korea its mission was to clear the air of enemy planes so that air superiority for the United Nations fighter bombers could be obtained.
